

NextMed/MMVR22 Poster Guidelines

Posters are an excellent medium for sharing research, with abundant data visualized in a graphically engaging way, and an important part of the conference. These guidelines will help you prepare your work for presentation.

- **CRITICAL:** Your poster **must** have a **vertical** or “portrait” orientation. The vertical axis can be a maximum of **40 inches (102 cm)** and the horizontal axis a maximum of **30 inches (76 cm)**. Because several presenters share the same display board, please stay within these dimensions so others have space for their posters.
- Your poster can be a single or multiple sheets of heavy paper or other suitable material. (Most posters are a single sheet.) You may laminate it but don’t put it on a rigid backing because it will be difficult to transport and mount. Your poster will be fixed with pushpins to a cloth-covered display board. We provide pushpins.
- If you want to distribute printed materials (brochures, cards, etc.) with your poster, place them in an open envelope and pin the envelope to the display board beneath your poster.
- Posters are grouped by topic. We will assign your location. If you have two posters, your posters will be together. If you want to be next to other posters from your institution, let us know well in advance.
- Posters will be put up starting Thursday morning and taken down Saturday morning. (You may remove your poster if you leave the conference earlier, of course.)
- The poster session will take place Thursday evening. During this session, we invite you to stand with your poster to share your research with other attendees.
- Members of the Organizing Committee will judge posters and select the best posters based on scientific merit and graphic design. Winners will receive prizes and commemorative certificates.
